



BloodSTAR - 'Do Not Prescribe' function

Medical Officers, Nurses and Midwives can add a '*Do Not Prescribe*' alert to a BloodSTAR patient record for patients who have had a known adverse reaction to an immunoglobulin product. If a BloodSTAR user tries to allocate a product listed under the patient's *do not prescribe* list, it will alert them to choose an alternative immunoglobulin product.

Steps to add a *Do Not Prescribe* alert to a BloodSTAR patient record:

Step	Action							
1.	Navigate to www.blood.gov.au/bloodportal and log in. Select the BloodSTAR tile.							
2.	Find patient under the Home page or Patients > Authorised Patients at this facility.							
3.	Alternatively, patients can be found through a patient search. Select the Patients tile on the BloodSTAR home page, select the Search option.
