




## BloodSTAR - 'Do Not Prescribe' function

Medical Officers, Nurses and Midwives can add a 'Do Not Prescribe' alert to a BloodSTAR patient record for patients who have had a known adverse reaction to an immunoglobulin product. If a BloodSTAR user tries to allocate a product listed under the patient's *do not prescribe* list, it will alert them to choose an alternative immunoglobulin product.

**Please Note:** Adding a **Do Not Prescribe** alert in BloodSTAR does not report an adverse event. Information about reporting adverse events can be found here: <https://www.blood.gov.au/reporting-adverse-events>

### Steps to add a Do Not Prescribe alert to a BloodSTAR patient record:

| Step | Action   |
|------|--|
| 1.   | Navigate to <a href="http://www.blood.gov.au/bloodportal">www.blood.gov.au/bloodportal</a> and log in. Select the BloodSTAR tile.  |
| 2.   | <p>Find patient under the <b>Home</b> page or <b>Patients &gt; Authorised Patients at this facility</b>.</p>  <p>Alternatively, patients can be found through a patient search. Select the <b>Patients</b> tile on the BloodSTAR home page, select the <b>Search</b> option.</p>  |
| 3.   | <p>Search for the patient either by <b>Authorisation Number</b> or at least <b>two search terms</b> (given name and family name together are deemed one search term). Select the <b>view</b> hyperlink to open patient record.</p>  <p><b>Result:</b> The patients record will open.</p>   |
