

Van Loghem et.al.

- “If I have seen further, it is by standing on the shoulders of Giants” (Issac Newton 1675).
- The day the textbook came in handy.
- Van Loghem et.al. (1957) just one of the 24 references cited in just over one page in a textbook on a dusty shelf in our lab.



The Patient

- Male, DOB: 15/12/34.
- 2002: Chest pain
- 2007- 2008: UTI, Gall bladder colic, Prostate cancer and prostatectomy.
- 2010: Dysplastic blood film. Hb = 109g/L, Plt = 69. Diagnosed with MDS.
- 2011: Myelodysplasia with blasts and episodic bleeding. Hb = 106g/L, Plt = 11



Discrepant blood group

- 23/12/11- Group and save: B pos negative antibody screen
 - Hb = 108 and Plt = 9.
 - Platelets issued over 3 months, when platelets less than 10.
 - On February 16th 2012 the patient noticed his blood group on paperwork was wrong!!!
 - Claimed it was AB pos???
 - Confirmed by Symbion (Lavery) and blood donor card as AB pos.
 - Sent off to RCRL where he was grouped AB pos.

??????????


- Why did we get the blood group wrong?
- Usual suspects of age, bone marrow transplant ruled out.
- “loss of or reduction of expression of A antigen due to disease” (Daniels, G. *Human Blood Groups*, 2nd ed. 2002).
- The MDS that was diagnosed in 2010!!!

Interesting!!!

- First grouped as AB pos in 2004 by Lavery Pathology.
- 2007 Lavery issued him over 10 units of B pos and O pos units. His blood films were relatively normal with a left shift of the myeloid lineage.
- 2011 presented with a leucoerythroblastic blood film.
- Last blood group in 2007 with Lavery was AB pos.
- So somewhere between 2007 and 2011 his A antigen expression was so reduced we could not detect it via card and the RCRL could only detect it by tube, with extended incubation.

DECEASED

- Patient died on 22/01/13 in palliative care.
- Pleuritic chest pain, decreased renal function and despite numerous transfusions his platelet count and haemoglobin remained low.
